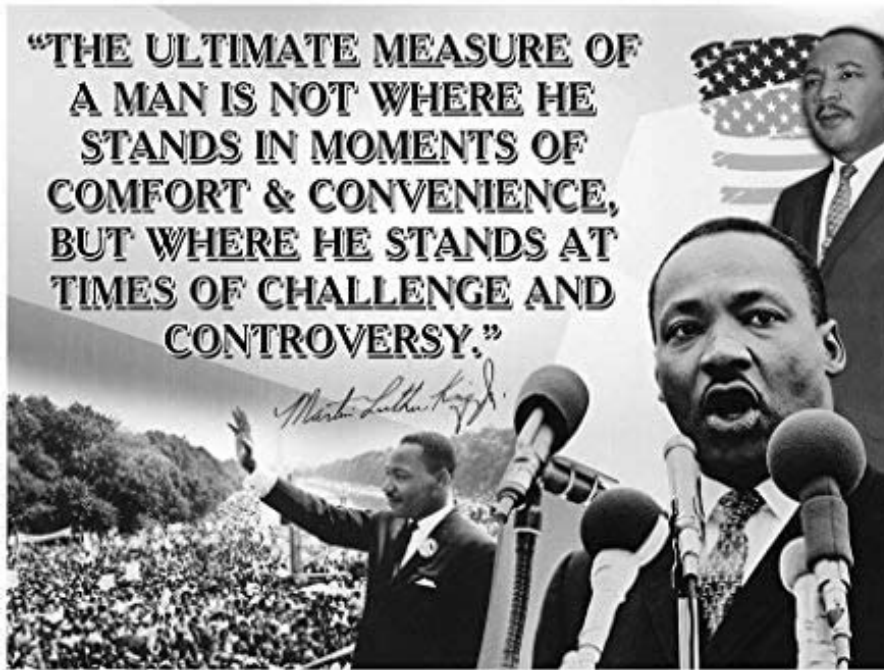

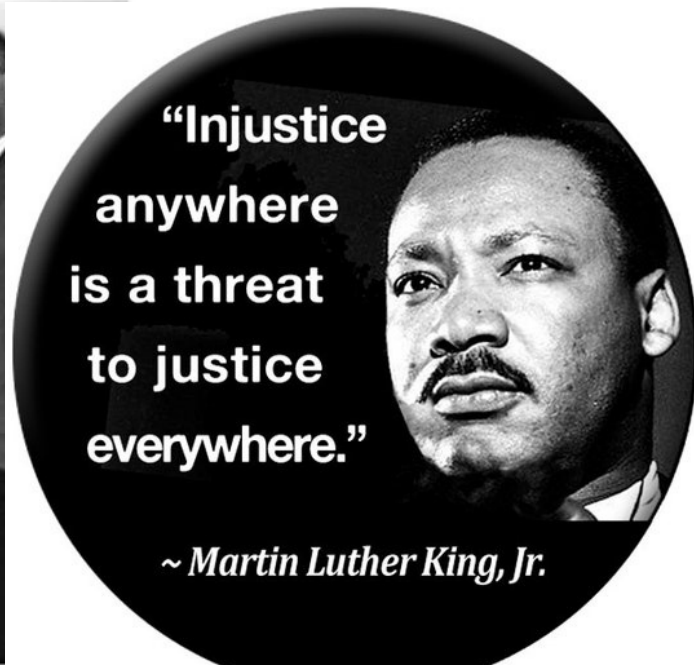

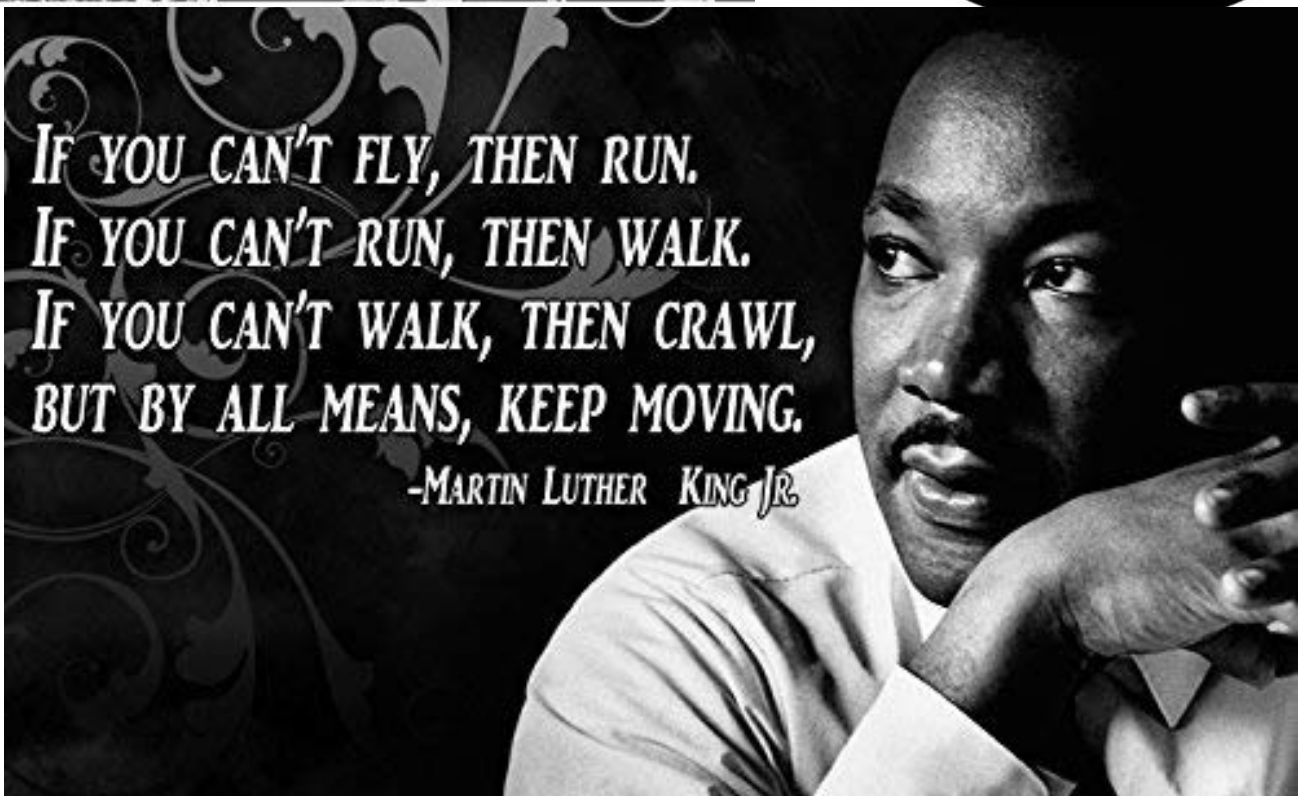

CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

All Citizens Police Academy graduates are eligible to become a member of the **Citizens Police Academy Alumni Association**. Meetings are held on the first Thursday of the month at rotating LMPD facilities.

Any graduates with an interest in continuing their education are encouraged to join. Guest speakers include government officials and representatives from various law enforcement agencies, including Kentucky State Police (KSP), U.S. Secret Service, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), and many more.

VOLUNTEERS IN POLICE SERVICE (VIPS)

All Citizens Police Academy graduates are eligible to apply for the **LMPD Volunteers in Police Service (VIPS)** program.

Any graduates with an interest in serving their local community by assisting the sworn and civilian personnel of LMPD are encouraged to apply. Volunteer opportunities include working special events/details, serving on Division Advisory Boards, providing administrative/clerical assistance, and many more.

What is the Citizens Police Academy?

The LMPD Citizens Police Academy (CPA) is a **free** 10-week program designed to educate the public about the police services delivered by the Louisville Metro Police Department. The CPA consists of 2-hour classes held one night per week for 10 weeks. A formal graduation ceremony for the participants is then held upon their successful completion of the program.

What is the goal of the CPA?

The goal of the Citizens Police Academy is to foster better communication between citizens and police through education and transparency. Everyone benefits when citizens understand the role and function of their police department. CPA graduates are well-informed citizens who possess greater insight into the complexities of police work who can then share their knowledge with other members of our Louisville community.

What will participants learn?

The Citizens Police Academy is a comprehensive program that provides participants with an overview of the various divisions, units, and functions of the Louisville Metro Police Department. Certified police officers, supervisors, and civilian instructors with particular expertise will cover each topic. Supplemental learning materials will be included in each participant's take-home packet.

When is the Citizens Police Academy?

The CPA is held twice per year. All classes are held on Tuesday evenings from 6:00 to 8:00PM. Most class sessions are held at the LMPD Training Academy located at 2911 Taylor Boulevard.
Spring Session: typically starts the first Tuesday of February and concludes in April.
Fall Session: typically starts the first Tuesday of September and concludes in November.

Who may attend the CPA?

Any interested person, 18 years of age or older, with no felony convictions, that lives or works in Louisville-Jefferson County is encouraged to attend. Community representatives (i.e. neighborhood, church, youth, and business leaders) are highly encouraged to attend. Classes are limited to **30** participants.

How do I apply?
