2022 VOTING IN KY



The city of Louisville, Kentucky, is holding general elections for mayor, metro council, coroner, county attorney, county clerk, county judge/executive, county commission, jailer, property valuation administrator, sheriff, surveyor, constables, county soil & water district, circuit court judges, circuit family court judges, district court judges, and justices of the peace on November 8, 2022.

Our primary election is scheduled for May 17, 2022. The filing deadline for this election was originally scheduled for January 7, 2022, but was moved to January 25 due to:-(redistricting.

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

The deadline to register online to vote in the 2022 Primary Election is next week; April 18, 2022 by 4:00 p.m. local time.

ABSENTEE VOTING is available for voters who meet certain criteria. All absentee ballots must be requested through the GoVoteKY.com portal. The last day to request an absentee ballot is 14 days before the election (PLAY IT SAFE!!! Request your absentee ballot ASAP! - Certainly no later than Monday, May 2, 2022.). Completed absentee ballots must be received by the county clerk's office by 6pm on Election Day in order to be counted. To qualify for a mail-in absentee ballot, you must fulfill one of the following criteria:

- Be of advanced age
- Have a disability or illness
- Be a student who temporarily resides outside the county where registered
- Temporarily reside outside of Kentucky (perhaps on vacation)
- Be incarcerated having been charged with a crime, but not yet convicted
- Have a profession that takes you out of the county during the hours the polls are open
- Participant in the Secretary of State's address confidentiality program
- Be a military personnel confined to a military base on election day
- Change of residence to a new state when the books are closed in election for U.S. President
