PULPIT COMMITTEE UPDATE REPORT ~ AUGUST 21, 2022

The following is an updated report from the Pulpit Committee of The First Baptist Church of Jeffersontown.

Some have asked, and many probably wondering, what is taking so long to find a Pastor. The national average timeframe to replace a Pastor in the Baptist church is 5 years. In the city of Louisville, it is 3-3-1/2 years. We first began meeting in July 2021. And, we have not yet met the 1-year mark from when we initially posted the position in November 2021. But we are happy to report that with a lot of hard work and time, and more importantly, by the direction of the Holy Spirit, we feel that we are ahead of the process.

Our last quarterly report was dated May 23, 2022. In that report, we informed the Church body that we felt led to open the posting again for 30 days. It was reposted in the National Baptist Convention's publication. The reposting ended June 30th. We received an estimated total of 61 resumes, with 26 being fully completed with the applications. We only reviewed the ones who completed the request.

All candidates from the first round have received rejection letters. We did not want to have someone waiting around when we knew they would not be considered as a viable candidate.

For the second round of candidates, we again followed our rubric that scored them based on Experience in the Ministry, Educational Qualifications, Work Ethic, other Pertinent Issues such as Baptist Denomination Involvement. Based on scoring their resumes, we met on August 1st to discuss the candidates' sermons, and scored based on content, presentation, congregation involvement, etc.

We are now down to 3 candidates to interview. These interviews will be conducted by Zoom.

If they have a successful interview, they will be introduced to our Church Family in person within the next few months. (Please see "tentative" timeline.)

They are to meet with Ministry Team Leaders, meet with the Deacons, and to preach on Sunday morning. We will have to plan a Zoom Bible Study, hopefully the Weds before they arrive.	Deacons to have Church family vote on candidates or vote to restart process.

God willing, if the Church family selects a Senior Pastor based on our final selection, we should be able to make an offer by the first of next year. He would be given ample time to make a smooth transition from his current church. Plus, to be able to move his family to Louisville. The Deacons are to meet with the selected candidate to make final plans.
