FBCJ COVID PROTOCOL REVIEW



As we are sure you all have heard, the COVID positivity rate in Jefferson County has soared astronomically. The last review revealed it was over 20%. At the height of the national shut-down last year it did not exceed 14%. With that in mind, new protocol guidelines must be established. The Deacon Ministry, after meeting with Pastor Gray and numerous Ministry Team Leaders (MTLs), have thus come to the consensus that we will not close the church, but for the immediate future, we will suspend in-house worship services. This means there will be no in-house Watch Night service (December 31st) or Sunday worship service at 11:00am on January 2nd and 9th, 2022. Also, there will be no meetings on the campus and the staff are required to re-establish all mask, handwashing, and other COVID protocols, when on the church campus. The Leadership is already meeting and sharing ideas on if and how we can continue to provide in-house worship service. Please know that whatever the final decision, it will be based on the safety of all members.

As Reverend Gray has stated many times regarding this pandemic, we and this country are experiencing something we have never seen before. Thank you for your patience and your continued support; it is needed as we all work through this. Your continued prayers about this and all matters concerning decisions regarding God's people, is necessary. We know the Lord will lead us in the proper direction.
